

CHINA DOLL

Radermoachera or Stereospernum

This plant's origins are Burma, Asia. Something new and different in our Garden Center. This lovely little plant combines a lush and lacy appearance with glossy, dark green leaves. In normal home environment, the China Doll is a hardy, vigorous plant that will grow 4 to 5 feet or more.

Temperature: China Doll appreciates temperatures in the range of 65 to 70 degrees F. The China Doll prefers diffused light (very bright but not direct sunlight).

Watering: Allow this plant to dry out moderately between watering and then soak it thoroughly. Provide it with additional sunlight and humidity during the winter months if at all possible.

Repotting: Soil based blend with plenty of humus or peat moss.

Humidity: The China Doll likes a humid environment. It benefits from a misting or standing in a oversize saucer filled with gravel which should be kept moist. This creates local humidity.

Fertilize: Feed with 20-20-20 or other soluble houseplant food. Be sure to use the recommended rate and the best time to feed is between April and October.
