

## **FAT GRASS**

### **The Lawn Renovation Program**

A great solution to lawn problems such as: thin turf in shade, dog spots, hard & dry soil conditions, and poorly established lawns. Fat Grass Formula gives better results than the traditional mixture of top-dressing and manure because it uses relatively sterile components free of insects and weed seeds.

#### **Tips for Success with Fat Grass**

- ☞ Rake and remove any debris from your lawn.
- ☞ Mix all ingredients together on a tarpaulin, in a wheelbarrow or on your driveway.
- ☞ Moisten the Fat Grass mixture first. Then spread it on your lawn using a shovel. Apply it evenly over the entire lawn area.
- ☞ Be sure to keep the newly seeded area damp throughout the germination period, with frequent, light-sprinklings of water. The mixture is light in colour when dry.
- ☞ Reserve a little of the mixture to repair any bare spots later in the season.
- ☞ Do not walk on the lawn or disturb the Fat Grass until the seed has fully germinated. (The length of time it takes for germination varies with temperature.)

The Fat Grass formula may be used on your lawn once each spring and again in late summer or early fall for optimum results. Two applications a year is recommended for lawns with weed or crabgrass problems.

Check with Plant World's expert staff before combining the Fat Grass program with a treatment for weeds or crabgrass.
