HILLS/HICKS YEW	3-5 FT	24" - 36"	MID-SUMMER	SUN TO SHADE
EASTERN/SWAMP WHITE CEDAR	5-15 FT	12" – 18"	LATE SPRING TO MID-SUMMER	SUN TO PART SHADE
EMERALD CEDAR	8-12 FT	30" - 40"	LATE- SPRING TO MID-SUMMER	SUN TO PART SHADE
PRIVET	4-10 FT	6" – 12"	JUNE & OR MID-LATE FALL	SUN TO PART SHADE
ALPINE CURRANT	3-6 FT	12" – 18"	JUNE & OR MID-LATE FALL	SUN TO SHADE
BARBERRY	3-8 FT	12" - 18"	JUNE & OR MID-LATE FALL	SUN TO PART SHADE

Spacing is specific to individual varieties and may vary. Consult with our nursery professionals for more precise details.

Remember to give all new plantings a slow deep water. The water should penetrate to a depth of 12" or more depending on the size of the rootball. A slow deep watering should be done once a week throughout the summer and fall, right up until the ground is frozen to optimize root development.

Fertilize with Plant World Plant Starter after planting to help roots get established. Continue to use Plant World Plant Starter to fertilize for the first year.
